OPENING QUESTION

How have your life experiences worked together to bring you to the place where you are now?

Be a Constant Learner - Paul the Polymath - Galatians 1:11-13

Paul was many things - a Pharisee, a tentmaker, multilingual, and grew up in a multicultural city.

What are you constantly learning about?

Let Your Passion Go - Paul the Zealot - Galatians 1:14

Paul began as a zealot for Judaism and the Law, but became a zealot for the mission of Jesus Christ.

What area of the Kingdom are you passionate about? Why?

Walk in Your Ordination - Paul the Missionary - Galatians 1:1, 15

We've all been called to be a missionary in our domains of society. The Church is the missionary!

What area of society do you consider your mission field?

Serve the Least - Paul the Advocate - Galatians 1:16-24

At first, Paul considered everyone who was not a Jew "the least" of society, then God gave him a heart for all who were lost.

Do you know people who are often considered "the least" in our society? How do you serve them?

Never Give Up - Paul the Human Being - Galatians 4:7, 5:16

Paul recognized he was a son of God, not a slave to God.

How do you see yourself when it comes to God? How does God see you?
